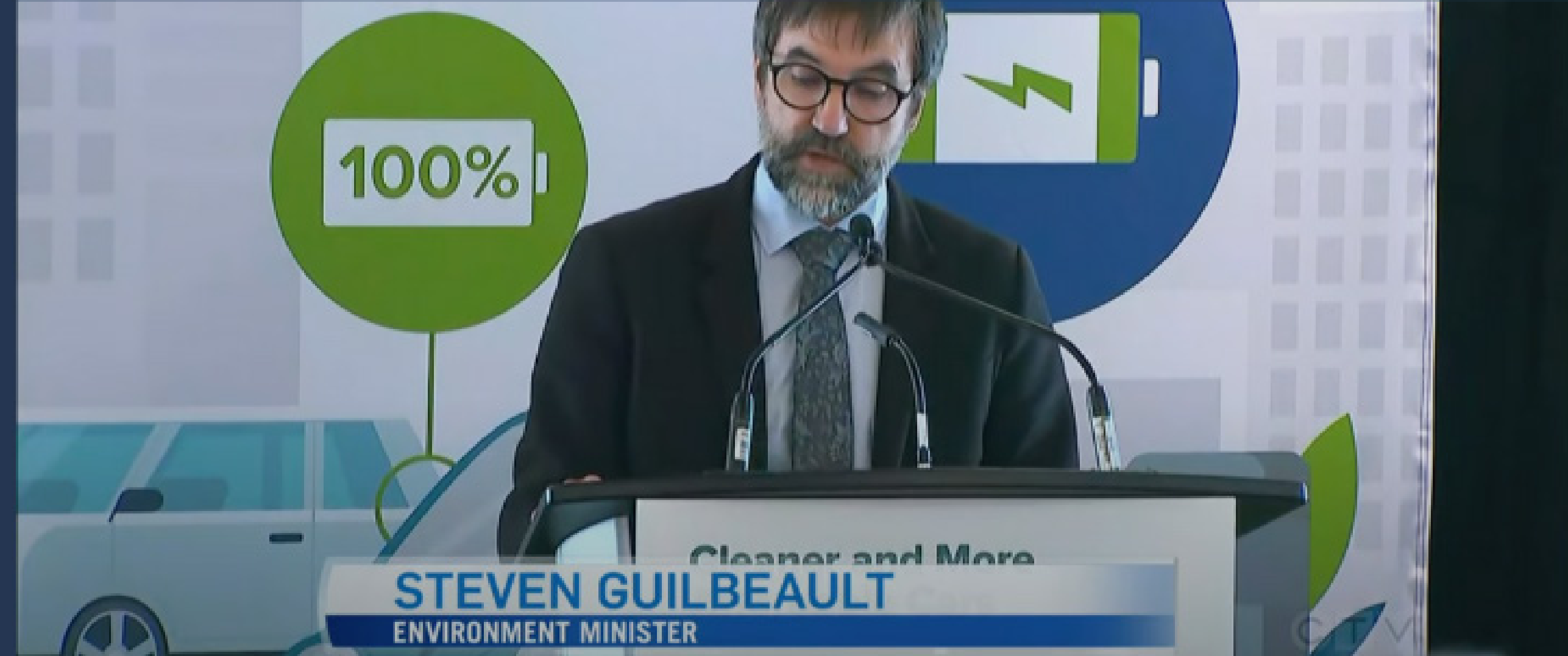


GLOBAL SDG GOALS SEE SETBACKS

CANADA'S GOAL TO PHASE OUT GAS-POWERED VEHICLES BY 2035

In a recent statement from the Canadian Environment Minister, it was revealed that the era of gas-powered vehicles is drawing to a close. The new regulations are being finalized mandating the transitions to battery-operated cars, trucks, and SUV's by 2035. To put this in perspective, approximately 442,000 EV chargers will be required by 2035. Currently, Canada has 25,000 EV chargers, with 85% concentrated in BC and Quebec. To successfully implement this plan, we must construct 35,000 chargers annually, emphasizing the need for proper infrastructure. Consider installing charging stations at your workplace to support your employees in this transition.
