



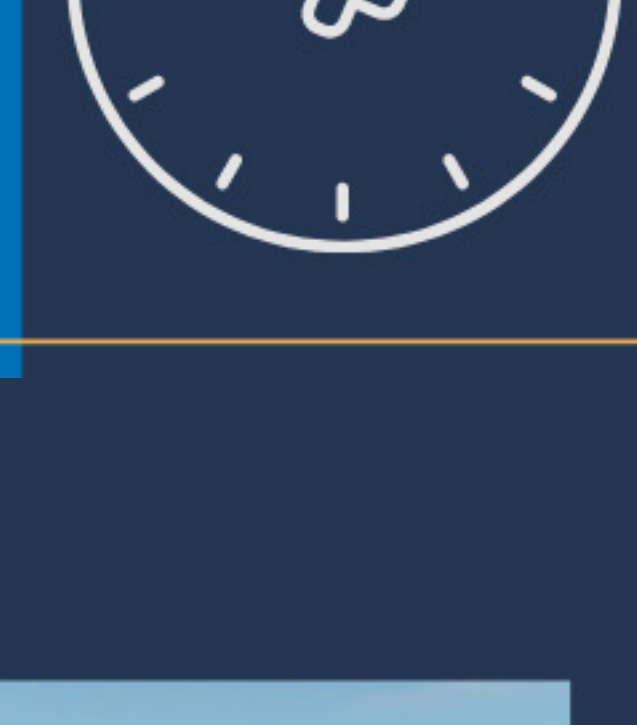

## IMPORTANT REGULATORY UPATE FOR OWNERS & MANAGERS OF LARGE COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS IN VANCOUVER

Energize Vancouver is now live! The new resource hub is designed to support building owners and managers in understanding and complying with current and upcoming bylaw requirements and to take early action to be prepared for compliance. The new Greenhouse Gas & Energy Limits Bylaw now requires owners and managers of existing large commercial and multi-family buildings to measure and report how much energy each building uses and the greenhouse gas intensity (GHGI) of each building.

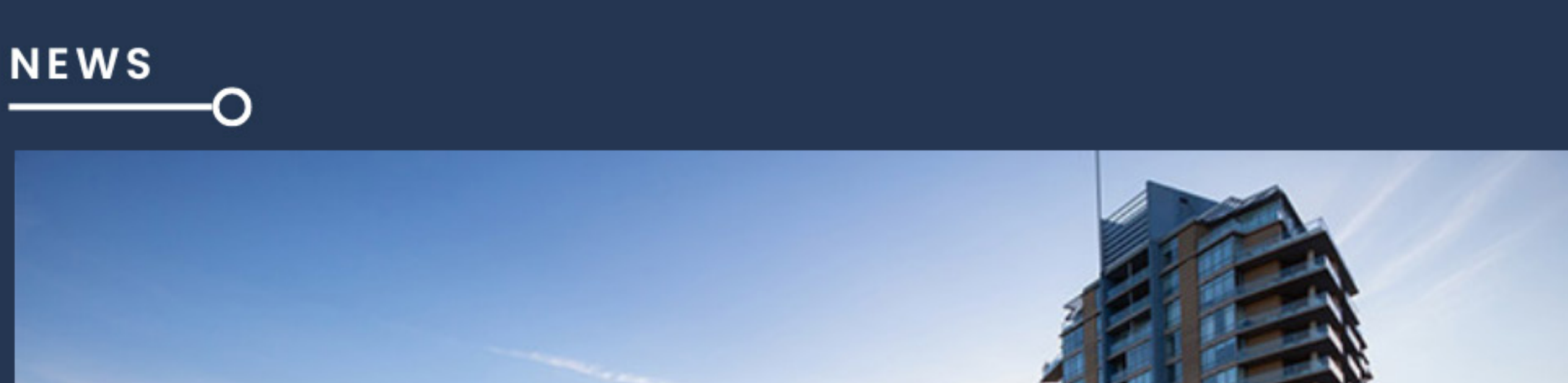


## CANADIAN FOSSIL FUEL SUBSIDIES HIT \$18.6 BILLION IN 2023, REPORT SAYS

The report comes ahead of a looming deadline the Liberal government set for itself to phase-out inefficient fossil fuel subsidies. In July 2023, Minister of Environment and Climate Change Steven Guilbeault said Ottawa would announce a plan to phase-out the public financing of the fossil fuel sector by the fall of 2024. Last year's subsidies raise the total over the past four years to at least \$65 billion, 10 times what the federal government invested in climate change adaptation since 2015 and enough to fund all of Canada's major solar and wind energy projects between 2019 and 2021 – twelve times over, claimed Environmental Defense.

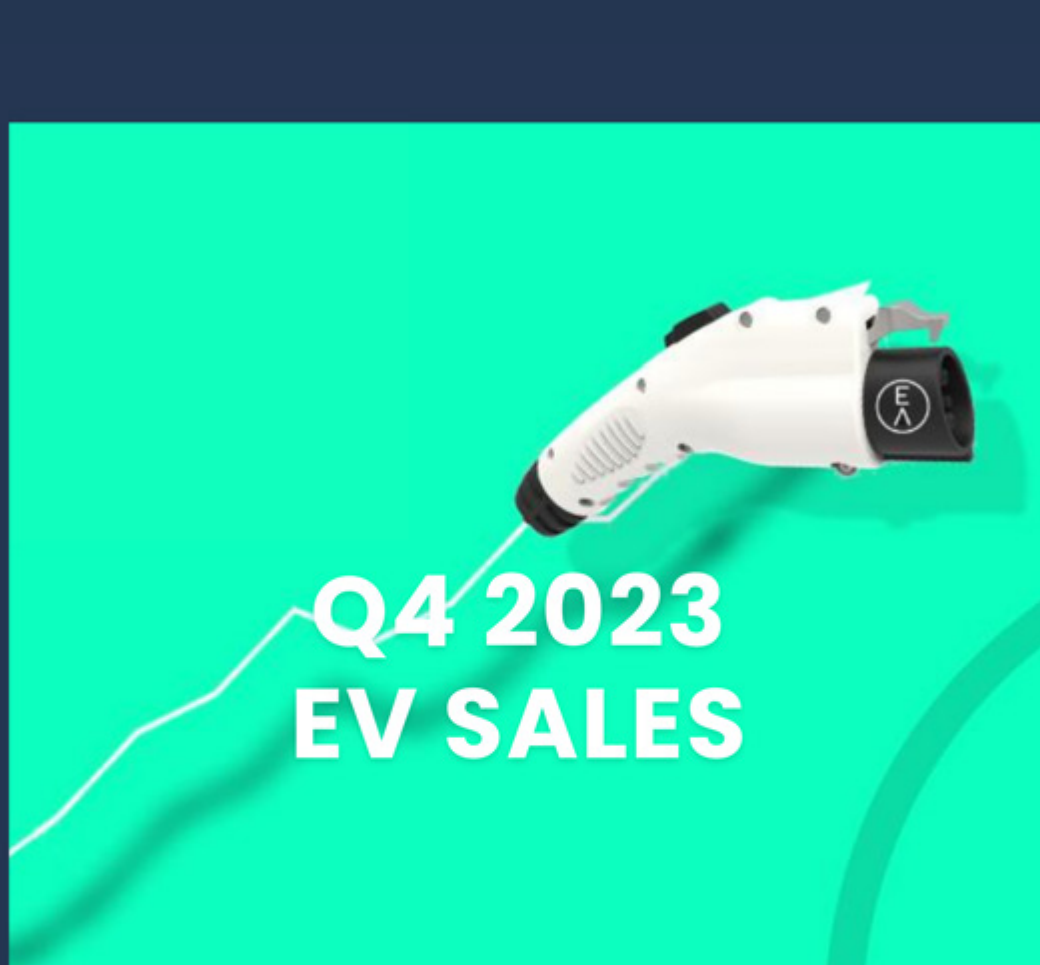


## BURNABY MAKES SWITCHING TO CLEAN ENERGY A PRIORITY
